## **Isaiah 65:24**

"Before they call, I will answer; while they are still speaking, I will hear."

About 10 years ago I was the communications person for the Pennsylvania Pro-Life Federation. One day I had about a two-hour drive to the city of Williamsport to do an in-studio radio interview/call-in show. I had the flu, but it seemed doable, so I went on my way.
